The **i2connect** project aims to fuel the competencies of advisors supporting interactive innovation processes to respond to multiple challenges in European agriculture and forestry.

#### WHAT IS INTERACTIVE INNOVATION?


A process in which actors with complementary knowledge (practical, entrepreneurial, scientific, etc.) work together to develop solutions to specific challenges, make them ready to be put into practice and disseminate results to a wider audience. **Interactive innovation** includes existing knowledge which is not always scientific. It encourages **co-creation** of practical knowledge and innovative practices.

### WHAT ARE i2connect SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES?

1. To strengthen the skills, competencies and attitudes of advisors to support interactive innovation, by identifying and sharing best practices, developing tools and methods, training, and organising peer to peer learning & networking;

- **2**. To enhance and profile the role of advisors in interactive innovation processes, at different scales: by a better understanding of the AFKIS\* at country level, by identifying providers of advisory services across Europe, by creating an enabling environment within advisory services, by better connecting and embedding advisory services within the AFKIS and by appropriate public policies;
- **3**. To **create a social support network and a networking culture** among advisors facilitating innovative innovation processes.
